Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal (LEEP)

The FBI's LEEP is a secure platform for law enforcement and criminal justice agencies. LEEP provides investigative tools and analytical resources to strengthen cases and share departmental documents.



Single-Sign On

In one centralized location, users are able to gain access by logging in using a single sign-on process. In other words, by using one username and one password, users can obtain access to many different resources and services within the LEEP.

Access

- Any authorized user from a federal, state, local, and tribal law enforcement agency that is an identity provider (IdP) can access the LEEP. An IdP is an agency that partners with the LEEP, which gives their users easier access to the LEEP resources. If your agency is a participating IdP, simply log onto your agency workstation.
- Anyone who has a LeepID account can access the LEEP. To obtain a LeepID account, go to www.cjis.gov.
